Oceania and NZ National Seniors & Veteran Championships 2022

Fencing North and Fencing New Zealand invite you to attend the Oceania and NZ National Seniors & Veteran Championships 2022 to be held at Te Pai Stadium, Henderson, Auckland starting on 22nd October and finishing on Monday, 24th 2022.

Eligibility

Entry is open to competitors from all countries in the Oceania Fencing Confederation.

To fence in the senior championship events fencers must be 13 years or older on 1st January 2022 (Fencing NZ Minimum Age Policy). If you are unsure whether the event is appropriate for you/your child, please check with your coach.

Veteran Fencers must be 40+ years old on 31st December 2022.

New Zealand participants must be affiliated members of Fencing New Zealand for 2022.

If you are not yet a member or your membership is not current please click on the link https://www.fencing.org.nz/membership/membership-options.

International fencers must have a current affiliation to their National Fencing Organisation.

Affiliations of all competitors (National and international) will be checked at time of entry. FIE Licences are not required.

Competition Format

Oceania & National Open Championship events: One round of poules (bouts to five points) followed by direct elimination (bouts to 15 points).

Oceania Team Event: Matches to 45 points, a match to decide third and fourth places will occur. For each weapon and gender combination there is an allowance for two teams per Federation.

Veteran Championship events: One round of poules (bouts to five points) followed by direct elimination (bouts to 10 points).

Events will be fenced as separate genders unless a minimum of six participants in a gender is not achieved, in which case a mixed event will be fenced.

Awards

Individual Medals: Gold, Silver and two Bronze medals will be awarded in each event.

Oceania Team Events: Gold, Silver and one Bronze medal will be awarded in each event.

Trophies: There are a number of National Trophies that are awarded at this competition. Weapon related trophies will be presented during the medal ceremony for that event. Other trophies will be presented after the last medal ceremony on 28th October. Trophies are not to leave New Zealand.

Registrations

Registration closes on October 17th at 8:00pm. Late entries close on October 20th at 8:00pm. After this date entry will be at the discretion of the DT and Referees representative.

Team nominations need to be entered by 17th October, please ensure team manager contact details are supplied.

Entry Fees: (NZ Dollars)

Oceania & NZ Senior Championship: \$90.00 for each weapon;

National Veteran Championship: \$80.00

Team Events: \$150.00 per team

Late Entries, received after 8:00pm on October 17th will attract an additional fee of \$50.00

Entry fees are payable via the entry system.

Multiple Discipline Entry: if you are entered in multiple weapons and your next one starts prior to completion of the first, you will be scratched from the start on the second event and are expected to continue to compete in the first event. No refund will be provided.

Equipment Standards

Any rules coming into force in the 2022-2023 season will **not** be applied.

All clothing must be in a good state of repair.

For Oceania and New Zealand Senior Individual and Oceania Team events:

	Leon Paul V blade without a unique serial number will
	not be accepted.
Sabre Specific:	FIE blades \$2000 or later are required.
Masks:	FIE Rules apply. Min 1600N Double Strapped
Wires:	FIE Rules apply – clear wires and plugs

Names do NOT need to be printed on Jackets or Lames.

All equipment is to meet all other FIE rules and standards.

Weapons, wires, masks, gloves, and conductive jackets (lames) will all be subject to a weapons control.

Please note: at foil and sabre, clear plugs on the wires will be required and only 2-pin body wires will be allowed.

For NZ Veteran Events:

FIE Rules are to apply except for the following:

Torso:	Minimum of 1150N protection. i.e an 350N plastron and
	an 800N Jacket or the reverse.
Breeches:	350N (CEN 1)
Foil Specific:	FIE blades are required with either Bayonet or 2-pin
	body wires. FIE no.3 size blades are acceptable.
Épée Specific:	FIE blades are required.
	Leon Paul SR-71 blades date stamped 2013 to 2015 will
	not be accepted.
	Leon Paul V blade without a unique serial number will
	not be accepted.
Sabre Specific:	FIE blades \$2000 or later are required.

Names do NOT need to be printed on Jackets or Lames.

Control marks: It is the fencer's responsibility to ensure that all equipment goes through weapons control and that the control marks are applied. It is also the fencer's responsibility to ensure that control marks are still present every time they go to the piste.

FIE Rule t.122: is suspended and will be as follows: Fencers will be required to salute each other in way of acknowledging their opponent and the referee.

Drug Free Sport: by participating in this event, you agree that you have been warned of the potential to be selected for anti-doping testing and you will comply with anti-doping testing if required to do so.
